



INTRODUCING THE OUTPOST 8.0

A long bed truck camper that is lightweight, provides four-season comfort and is capable of going where others can't.

WHY OUTPOST CAMPERS?

We started Outpost Campers in Southwest Colorado with one idea: build the most capable truck camper on the market and sell it at a great value. Every camper we make is hard sided, four season, and completely propane free, built by a small crew who camp in what we build.

At every expo we pulled into, somebody walked up to the camper, looked at it for a while, and asked the same question.

“Do you make a bigger one?”

For two years the honest answer was no.

Behind the shop doors, we went back to the drawing board. We designed, built, tested, and tweaked a prototype, took our show rig to events, and collected feedback directly from you all. The result is our second model, brought to life by popular demand: a camper designed from the ground up around the 8 foot bed, adding the space and functionality people had been asking for without giving up one thing that makes an Outpost an Outpost. A true four season camper. Light enough that your truck still drives like a truck. Built to get you where other campers turn around.

Today the wait is over.

CAMPER SPECS

The Outpost 8.0 is built to deliver full-size comfort and capability in a package designed around your 8 foot bed. From its durable four-season composite construction and 48v off-grid power system to its full wet bath, standing-height interior, smart kitchen setup, and north/south queen sleeping space, every detail is designed for real-world adventure. Below is a quick look at the key specs that make the Outpost 8.0 such a versatile and capable truck camper.

Dry Weight: 1965 lbs (with four jacks included)

Floor: 7' 6" L

Truck Capatability: Full size 3/4 ton trucks & up

Bed Size Capatability: 8' long beds with tailgate up. Shorter beds with tailgate off or down.

Interior Height: 76" H

Bed Dimensions: 60" W x 80" L

Exterior Dimensions: 49" W (wheel well) x 84" W (overall width) x 134.25" L x 87.5" H

Fuel Sources: Electricity, Diesel

Kitchen: Portable induction cooktop, 90l fridge, deep sink with folding faucet and cutting board.

Electric System: 5kWh LFP battery, 3600 watt inverter, 60 amp DC-DC charger, Dual solar MPPT charge controller, 500w solar panel, 30 amp shore power

Water Capacity: 40 gallons fresh, 20 gallons grey, 5 gallons black

Shell Construction: Composite construction is lightweight, incredibly well insulated & durable. Two piece aluminum extrusion system with thermal break.

Lighting: Dimmable overhead lights & under cabinet lights. Reading lights. Easy access porch & entry light. Bright rear scene light. Running lights on front and rear.



STANDARD FEATURES + AVAILABLE OPTIONAL ADD-ONS

The Outpost 8.0 comes standard with premium finishes and systems from day one. Unlike many campers that rely on long upgrade lists to feel fully equipped, the Outpost 8.0 is designed to arrive ready for real travel. Optional add-ons are there to personalize your setup, not to supply the basics.

WHAT COMES STANDARD

Kitchen: Portable induction cooktop, 90L refrigerator, deep stainless steel sink, and bamboo countertops across an extended aluminum cabinet run. A clean, functional galley with real counter space.

Sleeping: North/south queen mattress in the extended cabover with storage hatches on both sides, plus a dinette that converts into a roughly twin size second bed.

Bathroom: A full interior wet bath with a full height shower and detachable fixture, a fixed cassette toilet serviced through an exterior access hatch, and a sliding translucent door. No setup, and nothing carried through your interior.

Water: 40 gallons of fresh water, a 20 gallon grey tank, and a 5 gallon black cassette, all contained inside the camper. On-demand hot water provided by the Truma Combi.

Climate Control: Truma Combi D Comfort Plus provides forced air heat and hot water using diesel fuel. A Maxxair Deluxe fan above the dinette provides ample airflow throughout the camper and a dome fan with integrated light bar keeps the wet bath nice and dry.

Mounting: 4 manual camper jacks and an internal tie down system with a new port hole design for reaching the forward tie downs.

Electrical System: EcoFlow 48v Independence Kit with a 5kWh LFP battery (expandable to 10kWh), 500W rooftop solar, touchscreen control panel, and a prewired external solar port.

Construction & Finishes: Thermal transfer-free composite construction, lightweight aluminum cabinetry, bamboo countertops, in-floor storage, and 6' 4" of interior standing height.

AVAILABLE ADD-ONS: TAILOR IT TO YOUR SETUP

COMFORT & CLIMATE

48v Air Conditioner: Adds battery powered cooling with nothing plugged in and no generator running. Mounted over the dinette and the bed, where the cool air is most appreciated.

Insulated Rear Door Cover: Adds privacy and extra insulation at the rear door.

OFF-GRID POWER

Second 5kWh LFP Battery: Doubles total capacity to 10kWh for running the air conditioner, working from the camper, or long stays off grid.

400W Folding Solar Panel: Plugs straight into the prewired external port, so you can set it in the sun while the camper stays in the shade.

STORAGE & UTILITY

Rear Ladder: Makes roof access easier for cleaning solar panels or reaching gear.

Roof Rack: Adds flexible rooftop carrying capacity for gear, boards, or other adventure equipment.

MOLLE Panels: Add modular exterior storage for traction boards, shovels, jugs, and anything else you would rather not carry inside. Standard MOLLE spacing, so gear you already own bolts straight on.

Starlink Mount: A dedicated mount for your Starlink dish, so it rides securely wherever you travel. For remote workdays, weather checks, and movie nights far from cell service. Starlink Mini not included. Patent pending

VIEWS & LIVABILITY

Dual Front Panel Window: Adds more natural light and expanded 270° views from the cabover sleeping area.

FITMENT & LOADING

Camper Jack Extensions: Help with easier loading and unloading on trucks with wider tires, duallies, or larger fender flares.

TRUCK FITMENT & COMPATIBILITY

The Outpost 8.0 is designed for full-size 3/4 ton and larger trucks with long beds. At approximately 1,965 lbs dry, including the standard 5kWh battery and four mechanical jacks, it carries its weight low and forward so your truck still drives like a truck.

WHAT BUYERS SHOULD KNOW:

- Designed for full-size 3/4 ton trucks and up
- Closes the tailgate on an 8' bed, a rarity for a camper of this size and capability
- Fits standard beds with the tailgate down or removed
- Internal tie down system with a new port hole design keeps the camper secure without straps through the windows
- Water, gear, passengers, and accessories all count toward overall weight



KEY FITMENT CHECKS

- Confirm payload for your truck (or the one you are looking at)
- Measure bed length
- Measure width between wheel wells
- Measure bed-rail height
- Measure cab height from the bed floor

Keeping the tailgate up can add an easy way to secure the camper, preserve built-in tailgate steps, and create a useful porch area. The camper's approximate 24" center of gravity also helps it maintain strong drivability across long and standard bed setups.

HOW ORDERING WORKS

The Outpost purchase process is built to be clear from deposit to delivery, and it works the same for the 8.0 as it does for the 6.5.

STEP 1: RESERVE YOUR PRODUCTION SPOT

Secure your place in line with a deposit through the website.

STEP 2: FINALIZE YOUR BUILD

Several weeks before production, the Outpost team sends a form to lock in your options and create your Buyer's Order.

STEP 3: CONFIRM YOUR PRODUCTION DEPOSIT

A second payment equal to 10% of your final camper build cost secures your final configuration and place in the production line.

STEP 4: PRODUCTION BEGINS

Once selections and deposit are confirmed, the build begins and delivery details are coordinated.

STEP 5: CHOOSE DELIVERY

1. Pickup in Bayfield, Colorado
2. Pickup from a dealer
3. Ship directly to you

If shipping is selected, unloading may require a forklift. For full details and current terms, see the Purchase Process Guide on our website.

STEP 6: FINAL PAYMENT

The remaining balance is due 2 business days before pickup or shipment. Financing up to 90% of the final cost of the may be available.
