CAMPER SPECS

The Outpost 6.5 is built to deliver impressive capability in a lightweight, well-balanced package. From its durable four-season composite construction and off-grid-ready power system to its comfortable interior height, smart kitchen setup, and practical sleeping space, every detail is designed for real-world travel. Below is a quick look at the key specs that make the Outpost 6.5 such a versatile and adventure-ready truck camper.

Dry Weight: 1560 lbs (approximately)

Bed Size Capatability: Standard 6.5' beds with tailgate up. Shorter beds with tailgate off or down.

Shell Construction: Composite construction is lightweight, incredibly well insulated & durable. Two piece aluminum extrusion system with thermal break.

Lighting: Dimmable overhead lights & under cabinet lights. Reading lights. Easy access porch & entry light. Bright rear scene light. Running lights on front and rear.

Kitchen: Portable induction cooktop, 90l fridge, deep sink with folding faucet and cutting board.



STANDARD FEATURES + AVAILABLE OPTIONAL ADD-ONS

The Outpost 6.5 comes standard with premium finishes and systems from day one. Unlike many campers that rely on long upgrade lists to feel fully equipped, the Outpost 6.5 is designed to arrive ready for real travel. Optional add-ons are there to personalize your setup—not to supply the basics.

WHAT COMES STANDARD

Kitchen: Portable induction cooktop, 90L refrigerator, and stainless steel deep sink with cutting board for a clean, functional galley that is ready to use from day one.

Sleeping: RV queen-sized 5" memory foam mattress plus a dinette that converts into a second sleeping area for flexible overnight use.

Bathroom: Removable cassette toilet and indoor/outdoor quick-release hose for simple, practical hygiene on the road and at camp.

Mounting: 4 mechanical jack stands (with chucks for cordless drills) and internal ratchet tie-downs for secure loading and unloading.

Electrical System: EcoFlow Independence Power Kit with 5kWh LFP battery, 250W solar panel, dimmable LED lighting, and prewired external solar port. The standard system is built for real off-grid use, with multiple charging methods and room to expand.

Construction & Finishes: Thermal transfer-free composite construction, lightweight and durable aluminum cabinets, bamboo countertops and benches, two in-floor storage hatches, double-pane acrylic windows, and a locking door with screen. These are the details that make the camper feel more refined, more durable, and more comfortable in daily use.

AVAILABLE ADD-ONS: TAILOR IT TO YOUR SETUP

COMFORT & CLIMATE

FROLI Sleep System: Adds comfort and airflow under the mattress for better sleep and better moisture management.

DC-Powered Air Conditioner: Adds battery-powered cooling for stronger warm-weather comfort off-grid.

On-Demand Hot Water: Brings convenient hot water without propane or bulky tanks.

Indoor Shower Enclosure: Creates a simple shower setup inside the camper.

Diesel Heater Box: Adds reliable dry heat for cold-weather camping and higher elevations.

Insulated Rear Door Cover: Adds privacy and extra insulation at the rear door.

OFF-GRID POWER

Additional Rooftop Solar Panel: Adds another 250W rooftop panel for faster recharge times.

400W Folding Solar Panel: Adds portable solar capacity for longer stays off-grid and more flexible charging.

STORAGE & UTILITY

Rear Ladder: Makes roof access easier for cleaning solar panels or reaching gear.

Roof Rack: Adds flexible rooftop carrying capacity for gear, boards, or other adventure equipment.

MOLLE Panels: Add modular exterior storage for awnings, recovery boards, RotopaX, shovels, and more.

VIEWS & LIVABILITY

Dual Front Panel Window: Adds more natural light and expanded 270° views from the cabover sleeping area.

FITMENT & LOADING

Camper Jack Extensions: Help with easier loading and unloading on trucks with wider tires, duallies, or larger fender flares.

TRUCK FITMENT & COMPATIBILITY

The Outpost 6.5 is designed for some full-size half-ton and larger trucks. At approximately 1,560 lbs dry, including the standard 5kWh battery, it stays lighter and more usable than many traditional truck campers.

WHAT BUYERS SHOULD KNOW:

- Designed for full-size 1/2 ton trucks and up
- Fits standard 6.5' and larger truck beds allowing the tailgate to close (standard size beds on modern Fords, GMs, and other brands). RAM's with slightly shorter bed 6.4' bed lengths still work great but lose the ability to close the tailgate with the camper on.
- Water, gear, passengers, and accessories all count toward overall weight



KEY FITMENT CHECKS

- Confirm payload for your truck (or the one you're looking at)
- Measure bed length
- Measure width between wheel wells
- Measure bed-rail height
- Measure cab height from the bed floor

Keeping the tailgate up can add an easy way to secure the camper, preserve built-in tailgate steps, and create a useful porch area. The camper's approximate 23.5" center of gravity also helps it maintain strong drivability across long, standard, and short-bed setups.

HOW ORDERING WORKS

The Outpost purchase process is built to be clear from deposit to delivery.

STEP 1: RESERVE YOUR PRODUCTION SPOT

Secure your place in line with a deposit through the website.

STEP 2: FINALIZE YOUR BUILD

About 8 weeks before production, the Outpost team sends a form to lock in your options and create your Buyer's Order.

STEP 3: CONFIRM YOUR PRODUCTION DEPOSIT

A second payment equal to 10% of your final camper build cost secures your final configuration and place in the production line.

STEP 4: PRODUCTION BEGINS

Once selections and deposit are confirmed, the build begins and delivery details are coordinated.

STEP 5: CHOOSE DELIVERY

1. Pickup in Bayfield, Colorado
2. Pickup from a dealer
3. Ship directly to you

If shipping is selected, unloading may require a forklift. For full details and current terms, see the Purchase Process Guide on our website.

STEP 6: FINAL PAYMENT

The remaining balance is due 2 business days before pickup or shipment. Financing up to 90% of the final cost of the may be available.
